- 2. Access to Dentist: Audrain 30.66% as compaired to the state of 54.2% (Audrain Community Health Needs Assessment 2018)

Cavities are one of the most common chronic diseases of childhood in the United States. Untreated cavities can cause pain and infections that may lead to problems with eating, speaking, playing, and learning. Children who have poor oral health often miss more school and receive lower grades than children who don't. About 1 of 5 (20%) children aged 5 to 11 years have at least one untreated decayed tooth. Children aged 5 to 19 years from low-income families are twice as likely (25%) to have cavities, compared with children from higher-income households (11%) By age 8, over half of children (52%) have had a cavity in their primary (baby) teeth.(CDC) The good news is that cavities are preventable.
